

Legacy Connector Construction Update November 30, 2023

The construction focus for the month of November has delivered the concrete surface and initial railing work for the elevated portion of the Legacy Connector. As we move into December, the plan is set to complete the railings with the addition of protective screening, install plantings, and add the final layer of asphalt to the trail.

Reaching this stage of development is incredibly exciting! Before we can set a date for the Legacy Connector opening, we will need to move through the final inspection process with the City of Greenville. So, please stay tuned for big news in the next update!
